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NEWSLETTER

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Month of November started with the preparation for the sports Day. Whole month was full of different activities held inside and outside the school. Regular meetings with the subject In-charges were held weekly. Many disciplinary actions were taken in different fields. Some of the main activities that took place in this month are as follows:

1st November: **LIBRARY DAY** was celebrated in The Scholar School with zest and enthusiasm. Numerous activities were conducted in the school for the students as per their class level. Students of class I&II were asked to colour the sketches of English poets and authors. Class III & IV Students were asked to colour the sketches of Authors and poets of Urdu, Hindi and English and also write few lines about the author/Poet given to each student. Students of class 'V' presented short speeches on the topics- Importance of Library, Father of Library, How to set up a library at home or classroom, etc. Students of class VI & VII worked in groups to prepare cover pages of different story books and Course books. Students of class VIII presented the Biographies of different Authors/Writers and poets of all the three languages- English, Urdu and Hindi. The program was very well managed.

2nd November: **PTM OF HALF YEARLY** was held in the school. 90% parents turned up to see the result of their wards. The meeting was very interactive where many suggestions, complaints and feedbacks were discussed.

6th & 7th November: A **MEDICAL CHECK-UP** was organized in the school in collaboration with the doctors of Al-Shifa. This two day Check-up program was very fruitful for the students. All the students from class Nur – VIII were examined properly and students were prescribed with different treatments, medicines & tonics as per their health conditions. Blood group examination was also done along with ENT, dental check-up and eye check-up.

7th November: A special assembly on **MILAD-UN-NABI** was held in the morning assembly and was conducted by the different students along with Islamic Studies In-charge Ms Azra. They threw light on the life of Prophet Muhammad (SAW) and importance of this day. Students were also told about the need and importance of following the Seerah of Prophet Muhammad (SAW).

8th November: The Scholar School celebrated **URDU DAY** in high spirits in the school premises. Students and the Urdu teachers worked hard to make this event interesting, informative and praise-worthy. The programme started with Qirat and then a Speech on Allama Iqbal's life. His 'Tarana-e-Milli' was very well enacted by students. Role play of Nazm "Shehed Ki Makkhi" was well presented by students. Students of class VIII also presented Qawwali and Ghazal. Urdu In-charge Ms Nahid delivered an informative speech on the importance of Urdu Day. Students learnt new vocabulary of this rich language and they learnt many verses of Dr. Allama Iqbal. The event proved successful as it was appreciated and enjoyed by everyone.

18th November: **CHILDREN'S DAY** was celebrated in the school instead on 14th November as schools were closed due to harsh weather conditions. In order to make our students feel special on the day, teachers conducted a special assembly for children. Assembly was conducted by Ms Shagufta and Ms Sabiya Sultan. Program was started with Qirat recited by Ms Asma. Then a group of few teachers sang a song which was full of enthusiasm and encouragement for the children. Some fun filled activities like Qawali, Funny skit, rapid fire school related

questions etc. were performed by rest of the teachers. Program was concluded with a speech by the Principal who appreciated the efforts of the teachers and wished the students on Children's day with a moral message.

21st November: SPORTS DAY of Pre Primary Section was held in the Scholar School. All the students took part in various fun filled activities. The students of Classes Nursery to KG participated in different kinds of races and competitions which helped the students to develop some leadership qualities. Shields and prizes were distributed among the winners and participants by the Chief Guest Ms Rehmat-un-Nisa(Co-Secretary Womens wing JIH), Mr Rafeeq Ahmad (Secretary SBF), Mr Javed Ali(Member Ext. committee TSS), Mr Naufil P.K (CEO HWF), Principal, vice Principal and Administrator of the school.
