Subject: Grant of Provisional Recognition from Nursery to Elementary level (up to Class 8) in r/o The Scholar School, E-11, Abul Fazal Enclave-1, Jamia Nagar, New Delhi-110025 under Right to Education Act/Rules-2009/2011.

Sir/Madam,

With reference to your application dated 22.01.2026, I convey the approval of the Competent Authority for grant of provisional recognition of school from class Nursery to Elementary level (up to class 8) under Right to Education Act/Rules-2009/2011 for a period of three years w.e.f. 01.04.2026 upto 31.03.2029 or till the order to the contrary is passed by the appropriate authority, whichever is earlier.

The above provisional recognition is subject to fulfilment of following conditions:

1. The grant of provisional recognition does not in any way imply any obligation for recognition beyond class VIII.
2. The School shall abide by the provisions of Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education Act, 2009, the Delhi Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education Rules, 2011, DSEAR, 1973 and directions / instructions issued by the Department from time to time.
3. The School shall admit in class I (or in entry class, as the case may be), to the extent of 25% of the strength of that class, children belonging to weaker section and disadvantaged group in the neighbourhood and provide free and compulsory elementary education its completion.
4. For the children referred to in paragraph 3, the School shall be reimbursed in accordance with the provisions of sub-section (2) of section 12 of the Act to receive such reimbursements school shall maintain a separate bank account.
5. The Society/School shall not collect any capitation fee and subject the child or his or her parent or guardian to any screening procedure.
6. The School shall not deny admission to any child for lack of proof of age and shall adhere to the provisions of section 15 of the Act. The school shall ensure:
 - (i) No child admitted shall be held back in any class or expelled from school till the completion of elementary education in a school.
 - (ii) No child shall be subjected to physical punishment or mental harassment.
 - (iii) No child is required to pass any board examination till the completion of elementary education.
 - (iv) Every child completing elementary education shall be awarded a certificate as laid down in under Rule 22 of Delhi Right to Free and Compulsory Education Rules, 2011.

- (v) The students with disabilities/special needs are given inclusive education as per provision of the Act.
 - (vi) The teachers are recruited with minimum qualifications as laid under section 23(1) of the Act.
 - (vii) The teachers perform their duties as specified under section 24(1) of the Right to Free and compulsory Education Act 2009 and the teachers shall not engage himself/herself for private coaching.
7. The School shall follow the syllabus on the basis of curriculum laid down by academic authority/ NCERT as the case may be.
 8. The School shall follow the three language formula for teaching.
 9. A certificate from competent authority that the school building has been constructed as per latest National Building Code has to be submitted within three months.
 10. That the Management of the school shall create a reserve fund in the form of Fixed Deposit in the joint account in the name of Manager of the school and Dy. Director of Education (District concerned) equivalent to 3 months salary of staff or Rupees One Lac + Rs. 80/- per student within three months from the date of issuance of letter.
 11. The School shall submit latest School Building Safety Certificate / Structural Safety Certificate from Competent Authority, FIR NOC from Delhi Fire Service, Water Test Report & Rain Water Harvesting Certificate from DJB and School Health Certificate from MCD within three months from the date of issuance of letter.
 12. The School shall comply with the directions of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India regarding the arrangement made for transporting school students.
 13. Salary to the staff shall be paid through crossed Cheque/Electronic Clearance System.
 14. The School shall maintain the standards and norms of the school as specified in section 19 of the Right to Free and Compulsory Act, 2009 and the instructions/orders issued from time to time, the facilities reported in (Form 1B) are as under:

15. The school building is used only for the purposes of education and skill development of children.

16. The School is established by society registered under the Societies Registration Act, 1860 (21 of 1860).
17. The School is not run for profit to any individual, group, society or association of individuals or any other persons.
18. The school accounts are audited and certified by a Chartered Accountant and proper accounts statement is prepared. A copy each of the statements of Accounts should be sent to the DDE concerned every year.
19. The School furnishes such reports and information as may be required by the appropriate authority/ Government from time to time.
20. Except for seeking Essentiality certificate from the concerned authority, the school shall abide by the provisions of Delhi School Education Act and Rules 1973.
21. If the school is located in unauthorized / non-confirming area, it shall submit the following documents within six months from the date of issuance of the letter:
 - (a) Certificate from concerned authority of DDA that it has applied for consideration with reference to zonal development plan and DDA is considering its application.
 - (b) Certificate from SDM/ADM/ Forest Department that the applicant school is not occupying Government land, Gram Sabha Land and or protected Ridge land.
22. That the school shall get the approval of Scheme of Management from the Competent Authority within three months from the date of issuance of provisional recognition.
23. That the school shall make payment of salary and other admissible allowances to its teaching/non-teaching staff as per ongoing CPC through bank/RTGS.
24. That the school shall comply with the provisions of Section 10 (1) read with Rule 125 of DBEAR 1973.
25. That the school shall comply with clause 14 of order No. F. DE/15(56)/ACT/2009/778 dated 11.02.2009 in r/o maintenance of DRF. School shall also ensure to follow FN-21 Accounting by schools" as issued by the Institute of Chartered Accountants of India (ICAI) for proper accounting treatment.
26. That the school shall comply with the order No. DE.15 (305) /PSB/2020/Pt.File-1/5641-5647 dated 20.06.2023 issued by this Directorate regarding submission of renewed / updated certificates like Fire NoC, Water Test Report, School Health Certificate, School Building Safety Certificate / Structural Safety Certificate.
27. That the school shall comply with the order No. DE.15(305) /PSB/Misc./2020/Pt1. File-11/5658-5662 dated 21.06.2023 issued by this Directorate regarding appointment of Special Education Teacher(s).
28. That the school shall not run any unauthorized classes / section including Pre-Primary and Pre-School without prior approval of the Competent Authority.
29. That the school shall comply with the orders/guidelines of DoE and judicial pronouncement w.r.t. utilization/maintenance of school funds.
30. That the school shall comply with the orders dated 07.11.2017/guidelines of DoE and judicial pronouncements w.r.t. safety of the students and shall take all necessary steps to this effect.
31. That the school shall appoint adequate number of teaching and non-teaching staff as per prescribed Recruitment Rules and in accordance to the provisions of DSEAR, 1973 & RTE Act, 2009.
32. The school furnishes water test report issued by Delhi Jal Board.
33. The school furnishes Copy of FDR in joint name of the Manager of the school and Deputy Director of Education (SE) with extended maturity date.
34. The school furnishes Police clearance certificates of the teaching & non-teaching staff of the school.
35. Renewal of Registration of Society if any, be ensured.
36. The school shall ensure that it functions strictly within the statutory framework of the RTE Act, 2009 and DSEAR, 1973, maintains prescribed standards, and provides a

safe, inclusive, equitable, and conducive educational environment for all students. The school shall further maintain and furnish valid, authentic, and up-to-date compliance certificates, including but not limited to Fire Safety, Structural Stability, Health & Sanitation, Safe Drinking Water, Rainwater Harvesting, adherence to prescribed Land Norms, and all other statutory and regulatory clearances or compliance requirements as mandated under the relevant provisions of the RTE Act, 2009 and DSEAR Act, 1973 and instructions issued from time to time.

37. This approval shall remain strictly contingent upon adherence to all relevant rules, provisions, guidelines, notifications, and applicable conditions stipulated. Any deviation, deficiency, or non-compliance shall render this approval liable to review, modification, or withdrawal, as deemed appropriate.
38. As the recognition granted is provisional in nature and pertains to a non-conforming area, the DDE (District/Zone) concerned shall mandatorily undertake an inspection of the school after six (06) months and periodically for the purpose of ascertaining and verifying the school's compliance with all prescribed norms, standards, and statutory requirements.
